Hi Dancers

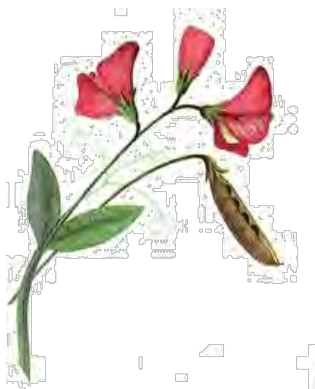

It is with a degree of sadness that we send a last newsletter for Shooting Stars S.D.C. after 38yrs. The following

are some of the reasons for this decision being made. In the last couple of years it has been difficult to attract new dancers in sufficient numbers to run on a separate night. We know from experience that trying to run beginners & regular dances on the same program does not work well, resulting in lost dancers. While we had enough dancers registered as regulars on our door records, we were continually struggling with low weekly attendances, a recent dance evening had to be cancelled due to lack of numbers. Trevor & Lorraine & some family members have all had recent & on-going health problems which have been a struggle over the past couple of years and as Trevor said, " We can buy lots of things, but we can't buy time". We thank all those dancers who regularly attended dance nights but sadly with continuing low numbers, it was difficult to maintain atmosphere for both Dancers & Caller. By way of thank you to all, Trevor gave a free dance on 2nd April and extends thanks to all Dancers, Callers & SASDS for attending both that & our 38th Birthday. Trevor remains a life-member of the S.A. Callers, SASDS and others & will remain keenly interested in Square Dancing in this State, he will continue to promote Square Dancing through One Night Shows & will no doubt visit clubs from time to time, he just will not be tied to a weekly Caller run Club now. 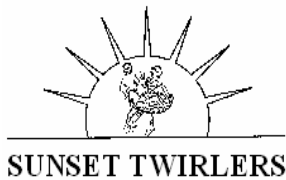
